Update on Enbridge Gas Construction

Enbridge Gas is about to begin construction on the Windsor Line Replacement Project in Tecumseh, Lakeshore and Chatham-Kent. We thank residents for your ongoing patience and support as we work to prepare for this upcoming project. Below are project plan details for construction that will occur this year on your road and in the area.

1. When will the project begin and end?

- Pre-construction activities will begin in April, and full construction will follow in May. The natural gas replacement pipeline is expected to be complete by October and the work to change over the gas service on your property to the new pipeline will be complete by December.
- We will begin to safely decommission the current pipeline in 2021.

2. What contractors will I see completing this work?

- Enbridge Gas and Aecon will be completing the work.
- Your service connection renewal will be coordinated by a Lakeside representative who will require scheduled access to your home or business to complete the renewal to relight your appliances.
- Your home or business will not be without natural gas for any length of time. An appointment will be made with you to complete this work.

3. What construction work will occur between now and the end of the project?

- Construction will begin with the installation of a new pipeline starting at Rochester Townline between County Rd 46 and S. Middle Rd in Lakeshore. One crew will move east, in the road allowance along S. Middle Rd to Lakeshore Rd 309, and continuing along Lakeshore Rd 309 to Chatham-Kent. When the project reaches Chatham-Kent it will continue along Wheatley Rd to Goodreau Ln. It will proceed along Goodreau Ln to Simpson Ln to Port Rd, ending in Port Alma at the Enbridge Gas Station. A second crew will move west from Rochester Townline, in the road allowance along County Rd 46 to the Enbridge Gas Sandwich Compressor Station in Oldcastle.
- Individual connections to the main pipeline (service lines) will be replaced from the new pipeline to the edge of your property line at no cost to you. A few residential services will require a full replacement, at no cost to you. An Enbridge Gas representative will notify you if required to discuss the plan.

4. What can residents expect as a result of this construction work?

- Our top priority is conducting our work in a safe manner that minimizes disruption to you.
- The work outlined above will be occurring primarily in the municipal road allowance, but some work will take place between road and your home and potentially across your driveway. An Enbridge Gas representative will describe the work planned at your home.
- To renew the service line in your yard if needed, either a trench or trenchless method will be used to install the new natural gas line to your home.

Information on Enbridge Gas' proposed Windsor Pipeline Replacement Project

In Essex County and Chatham-Kent, there is a need to ensure our pipelines and infrastructure continue to deliver natural gas reliably. With that in mind, Enbridge Gas is replacing the Windsor Line natural gas pipeline this year.

Our project involves replacing approximately 64 km of the existing Windsor Line, which is a combination of 8-inch and 10-inch diameter pipelines, with a new 6-inch diameter pipeline that will be constructed in the vicinity of the existing pipeline. This work will occur as described on the previous page across Tecumseh, Lakeshore, and Chatham-Kent. Please see the map below and the road list on the previous page for specific locations.
