

ENVIRONMENTAL REPORT

1. Dillon Consulting (“Dillon”) was retained by Enbridge Gas Distribution Inc. (“Enbridge”) to undertake a route evaluation and environmental and socio-economic impact study, which included a cumulative effects assessment, to select the Preferred Route for the proposed Bathurst Reinforcement pipeline which would serve to minimize potential environmental and socio-economic impacts that the project could have on the environment.
2. Mitigation measures designed to minimize environmental and community impacts were also developed as part of the study. The study results have been documented in the Environmental Report (“ER”) included in this exhibit. The ER conforms to the Ontario Energy Board (the “Board”) *“Environmental Guidelines for the Location, Construction and Operation of Hydrocarbon Pipelines and Facilities in Ontario”* (7th Edition, 2016)
3. The ER is included as Attachment 1 to this Exhibit and has been filed under separate cover due to the size of the report.

5. The ER was submitted to the Ontario Pipeline Coordinating Committee (“OPCC”) on June 13th, 2018. On July 13, 2018, the ER was resubmitted to the OPCC for review as the original ER was inadvertently missing figures. There were no changes to the evaluation and assessment of the pipeline route for the project.
6. At the time of submission of this Application, no comments have been received from the OPCC in regarding content of the Environmental Report. Enbridge will update

the Board regarding the OPCC review process of the ER should further information become available.
