

# ENBRIDGE GAS INC. NOTICE OF STUDY COMMENCEMENT AND INFORMATION SESSION

## Proposed Seaton Employment Lands Pipeline Project

Enbridge Gas Inc. ("Enbridge") is proposing to construct a pipeline to service a new customer in the City of Pickering. The Seaton Employment Lands Pipeline Project ("the Project") will include the construction of approximately 3.5 kilometres (km) of Nominal Pipe Size (NPS) 8" extra high pressure (XHP) steel (ST) natural gas pipeline. The pipeline will connect to Enbridge's existing NPS 16 ST XHP vital gas main at Sideroad 16 and Highway 7.

Public consultation with landowners, Indigenous communities, government agencies and other interested persons is an integral component of the planning process. An Information Session regarding the proposed Project will be held as follows:

The Information Session will be conducted as drop-in style, and representatives will be available to discuss the proposed Project including the proposed routes, design and the anticipated Project schedule. Input received will be used to inform the planning around the preferred pipeline route, and to develop site specific environmental protection or mitigation measures for the Project.

As part of the planning process, Enbridge has retained Stantec Consulting Ltd. to undertake an Environmental Study of the construction and operation of the proposed natural gas pipeline. The Environmental Study will fulfill the requirements of the Ontario Energy Board's (OEB's) Environmental Guidelines for the Location, Construction, and Operation of Hydrocarbon Pipelines and Facilities in Ontario, 7th Edition (2016).

It is anticipated that the Environmental Report for the study will be completed in January 2020, after which Enbridge will file an application for the proposed pipeline to the OEB. The OEB's review and approval is required before the proposed natural gas pipeline project can proceed. If approved, construction of the pipeline is currently anticipated to begin in late summer 2020.
