INTERROGATORY

Issue A.1.Need, Ref: Exh. A, T3, S2, pp. 7-8, 24.

- a) Please provide copies of all internal memoranda, planning documents, filings with the OEB, or other documentation of the Company's decision to postpone Parkway Phase 3 "following the additional procurement of STS capacity and the introduction of the first Demand Side Management program in 1995."
- b) Please describe the "Central Distribution Area on the TransCanada system."
- c) Please provide copies of all internal memoranda, planning documents, filings with the OEB, or other documentation of the Company's decision to postpone Parkway Phase 3 following procurement of "Firm Transportation capacity from Parkway to Central Distribution Area on the TransCanada system."
- d) Please identify all other T&D projects in the GTA that Enbridge has deferred due to DSM since 2003. For each such project, please provide:
  - i. The date of the deferral.
  - ii. The original and deferred in-service dates of the project.
  - iii. The estimated cost of the project.
- e) For each year, 2003–2012, please provide Enbridge's then-current T&D investment plan, including a list of then-planned demand-related T&D projects in the GTA, the expected capital cost for each of these projects, and the expected in-service date for each of these projects.

A review and reproduction of all documentation, including all internal memoranda, would require an inordinate amount of time and would not provide additional information of value in consideration of the issue.

- b) The Enbridge Central Delivery Area, or EGD CDA, is one of the delivery areas currently comprising the Eastern Zone for tolling purposes on the TransCanada Mainline. Contained in the EGD CDA are all of the gate stations which connect the TransCanada Mainline to the Enbridge Gas distribution system. When natural gas is delivered on the TransCanada system, it is delivered to the EGD CDA or the Enbridge EDA. Contained within the EGD CDA are two of the three weather zones within the Enbridge Gas distribution franchise area, those being the Central Weather Zone, of which the GTA Project Influence is a part, and the Niagara Weather Zone to the south.

- d) Enbridge has deferred no projects as a direct result of DSM.
