INTERROGATORY

Issue: A.1

A.3.6, p7, par 17

- (a) Please confirm that the pressure of the northeast portion of the line (Victoria Park to Buttonville) will not change. If not, please describe fully why the additional pipeline capacity below Buttonville will change the pressure in the upstream portion of the line.
- (b) What will the maximum amount of gas capacity that can flow per second through the NPS 30 line at thirty percent SMYS?
- (c) How much extra capacity will be provided by the north-south portion? What will the utilization of that capacity be in 2015 and in each of the next five years.

RESPONSE

- (a) The Don Valley line will have the operating pressure reduced. This impacts the entire length of the line. All references to pressure refer to the maximum setting on the source(s) of the line in question. Therefore, the pressure of the pipe segment from Victoria Square to Buttonville stations will be reduced. Please refer to the response to BOMA Interrogatory #15 at Exhibit I.A1.EGD.BOMA.15.
- (b) Gas flow on any pipe segment can vary as loads are taken off to feed the downstream systems. Please refer to Environmental Defence Interrogatory #25 at Exhibit I.A4.EGD.ED.25 for a summary of capacity at Station B.
