INTERROGATORY

Issue: A.1

- (a) Please provide the percentage of gas that Enbridge buys that is currently sourced from US supply basins, and from Canadian supply basins, showing for each basin, where the actual purchase takes place, for example, at Niagara, Dawn, Chigago, or US fieldgate; storage, or US pipeline interconnect.
- (b) Please provide a similar analysis for what the configuration of US and Canadian supply basins that will be in place once the GTA project is approved.

RESPONSE

a) and b) Please see the table below for Enbridge's current forecast of natural gas procurement by source of supply as a percentage of total supply for the years 2013 and 2016 respectively. 2016 is the first full year in which the GTA Project Facilities will be in service.

Western Canadian supplies source gas in the supply area of Western Canada and are transported either via the TransCanada Mainline or via Alliance Pipeline to the Company's franchise area. Peaking/Seasonal supplies source gas from other suppliers

in the Eastern Zone during the winter season. Ontario Production supplies are sourced from gas produced within the province of Ontario and are de minimus in relative terms. Chicago supplies source gas in Chicago and are transported to Dawn via contracted capacity on the Vector pipeline. Delivered supplies include those supplies sourced at Dawn. Niagara supplies are those supplies projected to be acquired at Niagara Falls and transported on the TransCanada Mainline to the Company's franchise area. Direct Purchase deliveries are those supplies delivered directly to the Company's franchise area by third parties.
