INTERROGATORY

Issue: A Related Issues

When did EGD identify the need for The GTA Project? What are the impacts of a delayed leave to construct – by 6 month and by 1 year?

RESPONSE

Enbridge continuously evaluates the needs to serve its customers in a safe and reliable fashion. The GTA project, as proposed, was identified in the 3rd quarter of 2011.

As per Exhibit A, Tab 3, Schedule 8, the impact of a delayed leave to construct by six months and one year would be a delay to the in service date of the proposed facilities by the same duration or more.

As stated in Exhibit A, Tab 3, Schedule 1, the facilities are required in order to meet forecasted minimum system pressure and operation requirements in the winter of 2015/16. As well, the benefits of the project as identified in that schedule, such as entry point diversity and upstream risk optimization and cost savings, would not accrue until the facilities are in place.
