

ARCHAEOLOGICAL ASSESSMENT

1. Stage 1 and 2 Archaeological Assessments (“AA”) for the wells to be drilled were completed by Stantec Consulting Inc. (“Stantec”). The AA for Wells TD28H and TD29H is set out in Attachment 1 to this Exhibit. The AA for Well TD26 is set out in Attachment 2 to this Exhibit. The AA for Well TD27 is set out in Attachment 3 to this Exhibit.
2. The Stage 1 and 2 AA for Well TD26 was finalized on September 21, 2016 and was submitted to the Ministry of Tourism, Culture and Sport (“MTCS”). The Stage 1 and 2 AA was accepted into the Ontario Public Register of Archaeological Reports on September 29, 2016. The acceptance letter can be found in Attachment 4 to this Exhibit.
3. The Stage 1 and 2 AA for Wells TD28H and TD29H were finalized on December 6, 2017 and were submitted to the MTCS. The Stage 1 and 2 AA was accepted into the Ontario Public Register of Archaeological Reports on December 7, 2017. The acceptance letter can be found in Attachment 5 to this Exhibit.
4. The Stage 1 and Stage 2 AA for Well TD27 was finalized on September 7, 2018 and was submitted to the MTCS. The Stage 1 and Stage 2 AA is currently under review by the MTCS. Enbridge will provide confirmation of acceptance into the Ontario Public Register of Archaeological Reports to the Board upon receipt from the MTCS.
5. The Stage 1 AA for all wells (TD26, TD27, TD28H and TD29H) determined that the study areas exhibited potential for the identification and recovery of archaeological resources. As such, it was recommended that a Stage 2 AA be carried out in areas to be impacted by construction activities.

6. The Stage 2 AA for all wells (TD26, TD27, TD28H and TD29H) identified no archaeological resources within the study areas and therefore, recommended that no further archaeological assessment of the study areas were required.
