

NOTICE OF APPLICATION

Enbridge Gas has applied to the Ontario Energy Board for approval to discontinue its hydrogen gas rider (Rider M) effective October 1, 2026

Enbridge Gas has applied to the Ontario Energy Board to discontinue the rate credit known as Rider M which applies to approximately 3,600 customers in the City of Markham who receive natural gas blended with hydrogen under a pilot project that began in 2021. Enbridge Gas will cease the hydrogen blending pilot project on September 30, 2026, and resume supplying those customers with unblended natural gas. Enbridge Gas has requested OEB approval to discontinue Rider M and remove it from its Rate Handbook effective October 1, 2026.

Enbridge Gas stated that it will inform all impacted customers of the upcoming conclusion of the hydrogen blending project.

Enbridge Gas requested that the application be decided without a hearing. If you believe a hearing is needed, you can request one by filing a letter with the OEB no later than **October 5, 2026**. You should indicate whether you have a preference for the hearing to be oral, electronic or written. If you do not file a letter by the due date, you will not receive any further notice in the event the OEB proceeds with a hearing. If you submit a letter, your name and the content of your letter will be put on the public record and the OEB website.
