

# NOTICE OF A RATE HEARING

## Enbridge Gas Inc. has applied to change its natural gas distribution rates effective January 1, 2026

Enbridge Gas Inc. (Enbridge Gas) has applied to the Ontario Energy Board (OEB) to change its natural gas distribution rates effective January 1, 2026.

The requested rate increases are set using an OEB-approved formula, which is tied to inflation and other factors intended to promote efficiency. If the application is approved as filed, a typical residential customer and a typical general service customer of Enbridge Gas would see the following changes:

Other customers, including businesses, will also be affected. It's important to review the application carefully to determine whether you may be affected by the proposed changes.

Enbridge Gas has also requested:

- A Z-factor treatment for the revenue requirement impact attributable to working capital changes resulting from the consumer Federal Carbon Charge being set to zero effective April 1, 2025
- Updates to Miscellaneous Service Charges and Rider M (the hydrogen gas rate rider)
- Updated unit rates for the Panhandle Regional Expansion Project (PREP) for Rate 331, Rate 332, Rate M16, and Rate M17

## YOU SHOULD KNOW

There are three types of OEB hearings: oral, electronic and written. The OEB plans to proceed with, a written hearing. If you think a different hearing type is needed, you can write to us to explain why.

During this hearing, we will hear questions and arguments from participants about this case. We will also hear questions and arguments from participants that have registered as Intervenorors. After the hearing, we will decide whether to approve the application.

If you write a letter of comment, your name and the content of your letter will be put on the public record and the OEB website. If you are a business or if you apply to become an intervenor, all the information you file will be on the OEB website.
