
Enerline Multi-Factor Authentication (MFA)

Setting up Desktop MFA


- 1. Log into Enerline and navigate to Support | Multi-Factor Authentication.
 - a. This will log you into the Okta application which will display in a new window.




2. From the Okta application under 'Security Methods', select the **Set up** button beside Google Authenticator.



3. Enter your Enerline account password.



4. From the 'Set up security methods' screen, select the **Set up** button under Google Authenticator.






5. From the QR Code screen, select 'Can't scan?' located under the QR code.



6. Double click on the key (contains various letters and numbers) located in the box in the middle of the screen.



- 7. Use CTRL + c to copy the key.
- 8. Navigate to your desktop authenticator application.
- 9. With your desktop authenticator application, select to add a new account.
- 10. Paste the key in the appropriate field within your desktop authenticator application.
- 11. Follow the instructions of your desktop authenticator application to complete the set up.
- 12. You have proactively completed the MFA set up process. Close the MFA set up tab and you can return to Enerline activities.

Note: When MFA becomes a mandatory step in the log in process, you will be prompted to enter your six-digit authenticator code when logging in to Enerline. In the meantime, you can log in to Enerline as usual.
