




Enbridge Gas North Carolina Commodity Portfolio

2028 Interstate Capacity by Pipeline










Gas fired power generation activity






Cumulative Power Generation Deliveries





Data Center demand surges

- Power generation demand is increasing in all jurisdictions
 - 950 MW Trumbull Energy Center in Ohio
 - 1.4 GW Duke Roxboro plant in NC
 - 200 MW Novva Data Center in Utah
- High number of data center inquiries from developers and end use customers
 - Tracking +3.4 BCF/d in active inquiries
- Customers placing high value on key competitive advantages:
 - Speed to market capability
 - High reliability infrastructure requirements
 - Redundancy solutions through infrastructure and supply diversity
