**Dawn to Parkway Firm Transportation Binding Reverse Open Season
Enbridge Gas Inc. M12, M12X, or M17 Transportation Services**

Enbridge Gas Inc. ("**Enbridge Gas**"), recently conducted a new capacity open season for new M12, M12X or M17 transportation service on the Dawn to Parkway System (the "**Open Season**"). The Open Season commenced February 23, 2026, and closed on April 23, 2026. Details of the Open Season can be found [here](#).

Incremental requests for transportation service on the Dawn to Parkway System arising from the Open Season may be satisfied through the expansion of physical facilities on the Dawn to Parkway System, through existing capacity turnback, or through a reduction in the current contractual commitments with existing shippers. Consequently, in order to maintain the most efficient use of the Dawn to Parkway System and minimize the overall costs to our shippers, Enbridge Gas is conducting this binding reverse open season ("**Reverse Open Season**"). We are soliciting interest from current shippers that want to turn back capacity on the following paths before the end of their contract term:

- (a) Dawn (Facilities) to Parkway
- (b) Kirkwall to Parkway
- (c) Dawn to Kirkwall
- (d) Dawn to Dornoch

Your cooperation in completing the attached Binding Reverse Open Season Bid Form ("**Bid Form**") will serve to advise Enbridge Gas of your binding commitment to turn back, or reduce, existing contracted transportation capacity.

To be eligible to turn back transportation capacity, **Bid Forms must be received prior to 1:00 p.m. Eastern Time on September 28, 2026**. Enbridge Gas expects to confirm receipt of all bids by October 2, 2026. If a bid is accepted, Enbridge Gas will notify the successful bidder(s) accordingly **no later than nine months in advance of the requested turnback date**. Requests will be ranked and accepted according to lowest Net Present Value. For example, a contract with two years remaining in the contract term would be accepted ahead of a similar contract with five years remaining in the contract term. Any and all turnback requests will be binding upon the transportation contract holder ("**Shipper**") and conditional upon Enbridge Gas executing contracts for new capacity with **all** conditions within those contracts, including but not limited to the condition that the new facilities have been placed into service, being satisfied or waived, for new contracted capacity that is expected to commence November 1, 2029 or November 1, 2030.

Shippers who currently have an option to provide notice of termination of their existing transportation contracts by Oct. 31, 2027, and who wish to turn capacity back to Enbridge Gas (in whole or in part) may participate in this Reverse Open Season (preferable), or they may wait and provide notice by Oct. 31, 2027, as per the renewal provisions in their contract.



When evaluating the Reverse Open Season, please consider that should Enbridge Gas deem that new facilities are required, Dawn-Parkway tolls may increase 30-45% when the new facilities have been placed into service.

Enbridge Gas may also request Ontario Energy Board (“**OEB**”) approval for a term-up provision for shippers who currently hold easterly service from Dawn (Facilities) or Kirkwall to Parkway as part of any regulatory filing for the construction of new facilities. The term-up provision would require the shipper to extend the term of their current contract after the in-service date of any new facilities subject to OEB approval.

Enbridge Gas, as its sole discretion, reserves the right to reject any and all bid proposals received.

If a Shipper's Bid is accepted, with or without conditions, Enbridge Gas will notify the Shipper accordingly no later than nine months in advance of the requested turnback date. Any and all turnback requests will be binding upon the Shipper and conditional upon Enbridge Gas executing contracts for new capacity with **all** conditions within those contracts, including but not limited to the condition that the new facilities have been placed into service, being satisfied or waived, for capacity commencing November 1, 2029 or November 1, 2030.
