Ongoing construction

Things are moving along as we progress. Enbridge Gas expects some of the project to be in-service this winter. Mainly Centreline Rd. (County Rd. 10) and Pigeon Lake Rd. as well a number of business and residences on the edge of Bobcaygeon along County Rd. 36.

Bobcaygeon Community Expansion Project consists of up to 115 km of natural gas pipeline from Cowan's Bay to Bobcaygeon.



This is a \$115 million project that will promote economic growth in Northern Ontario for years to come.



Construction started summer 2024 and is scheduled to be completed by the end of 2027.



Many employees and contractors are on site to complete the project.


