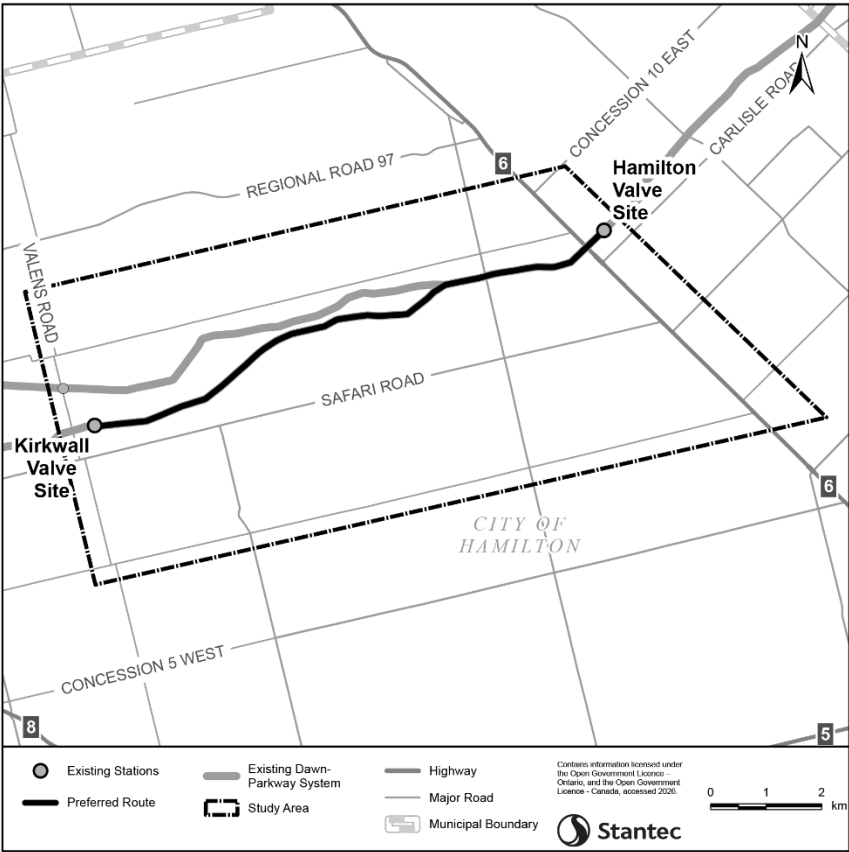

Notice of Upcoming Environmental Study
Dawn Parkway System Renewal Project: Kirkwall to Hamilton

This notice is to inform you of an upcoming Enbridge Gas Inc. (Enbridge Gas) Environmental Study taking place in southwestern Ontario for a potential project that is in early development called the “Dawn Parkway System Renewal Project.” The Dawn Parkway Transmission System was built in the 1950s and is the backbone of the natural gas system supporting energy security and economic competitiveness in Ontario and across Canada. It is part of a broader integrated supply network that serves homes and businesses across 500 municipalities in Ontario, Quebec, the Maritimes, and the Northeastern United States.

Through its integrity management program, Enbridge Gas identified several proactive measures to maintain capacity, safety, and reliability, ranging from targeted segment replacements to broader line upgrades. For this Environmental Study, Enbridge Gas is considering improvements to install new 48-inch diameter natural gas pipeline between its existing Kirkwall Valve Site, located northeast of the intersection of Safari Road and Valens Road and the existing Hamilton Valve Site, located east of Highway 6 and north of Carlisle Road. The proposed pipeline location was determined through a route selection process conducted in 2019 and is generally parallel to the three existing Enbridge Gas pipelines, measuring approximately 10.2 km in length. New permanent easements and temporary working space during construction will be required. The study area, existing infrastructure, and Preferred Route are shown in the figure.



Enbridge Gas has retained a third-party environmental consultant, Stantec Consulting Ltd. (Stantec), to reaffirm the findings of the 2019 Kirkwall to Hamilton Environmental Report which will be added as an addendum and will fulfill the requirements of the Ontario Energy Board’s (OEB) *Environmental Guidelines for the Location, Construction, and Operation of Hydrocarbon Projects and Facilities in Ontario, 8th Edition (2023)*.

It is anticipated that the Addendum to the Environmental Report will be completed in Q1 2027, after which Enbridge Gas plans to file a Leave to Construct application for the Project with the OEB. The OEB’s review and approval is required before the proposed Project can proceed. If approved, construction is anticipated to begin in the spring of 2028.

Enbridge Gas is committed to undertaking consultation and engagement with stakeholders, Indigenous communities, and the public as an integral component of the Environmental Study. Additional details about the Environmental Study and how to become involved during the consultation and engagement process will be provided in future correspondence.
