## Natural gas rates have changed

### New natural gas rates

The Ontario Energy Board (OEB) has approved changes to the rates Enbridge Gas charges its customers effective **Jan. 1, 2026**.

A typical commercial and industrial customer will see an annual increase of 9.3 percent. The total impact on your bill will depend on how much gas you use.

#### **Customer Charge**

The customer charge increased to \$85.78 a month to partially recover some of the fixed costs associated with maintaining a safe and reliable natural gas distribution system.

#### **Delivery to You**

The delivery charges that vary with consumption increased based on our forecast cost of delivering natural gas to your home or business. These charges include a facility carbon charge associated with the operation of Enbridge Gas' facilities to deliver natural gas to you. The facility carbon charge has increased from 0.0123 cents per cubic metre (¢/m<sup>3</sup>) to 0.0145 ¢/m<sup>3</sup>.

#### **Transportation to Enbridge**

The transportation charge has decreased by approximately \$110.30 per year for a typical customer due to lower costs for transporting natural gas to Ontario.

#### **Gas Supply Commodity Charge**

The gas supply commodity charge has increased from 17.4609 ¢/m<sup>3</sup> to 20.7163 ¢/m<sup>3</sup> based on our forecast of natural gas market prices for the next 12 months.

#### **Cost Adjustment**

The current adjustment is a refund of 1.7605 ¢/m<sup>3</sup>. The cost adjustment reflects the true-up between actual and forecast prices for prior periods. Please see the included chart for the breakdown by component.

#### **Rate Adjustment**

This rate change includes an adjustment to reflect the clearance of the 2023 Utility Earnings and Disposition of Deferral and Variance Account (UEDVA) balances. This will appear on customers' January bills as a one-time charge of approximately \$601.02 for a typical customer.

Charges for gas used from Jan. 1, 2026 will be calculated using the new approved rates as shown in the chart. The annualized impact is based on a typical Rate 10 - Union North East customer who uses 93,000 cubic metres (m<sup>3</sup>) per year.

\* The total effective gas supply rate shown on your bill is 19.0366 ¢/m<sup>3</sup>. This rate is the sum of the gas supply commodity charge of 20.7163 ¢/m<sup>3</sup> and the gas cost adjustment of (1.6797) ¢/m<sup>3</sup>. The total effective gas supply charge has increased since the last rate change.

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
