Natural gas rates have changed

New natural gas rates

The Ontario Energy Board (OEB) has approved changes to the rates Enbridge Gas charges its customers effective **July 1, 2026**.

The total impact on your bill will depend on how much gas you use and the terms of your gas marketer agreement.

Delivery to You

The delivery charges that vary with consumption decreased based on our forecast cost of delivering natural gas to your home or business. These charges include a facility carbon charge associated with the operation of Enbridge Gas' facilities to deliver natural gas to you.

Gas Supply Commodity Charge

The price you pay for the natural gas you use, shown as the gas supply charge on your bill, depends on the terms of your gas marketer agreement.

Rate Adjustment

This rate adjustment reflects the difference between the amount customers paid for the energy conservation programs (DSM) from Jan. 1 to Dec. 31, 2023 and the actual costs incurred. This will appear on customers' July bills as a one-time refund of approximately \$336.49 for a typical customer.

Charges for gas used from July 1, 2026 will be calculated using the new approved rates as shown in the chart. The annualized impact is based on a typical Rate M2 - Union South customer who uses 73,000 cubic metres (m³) per year while buying gas from an energy marketer.
