Natural Gas Prices Have Changed

The Ontario Energy Board (OEB) has approved changes to the rates Enbridge Gas charges its customers effective **Jan. 1, 2026**.

On average, these changes will amount to an increase of approximately 9.9 percent annually. The total impact on your bill will depend on how much gas your organization uses.

Your current bill has been calculated using the new approved rates for gas consumed from Jan. 1, 2026. The rate chart is included in this notice.

Our supply prices are based on a forecast of market prices for the next 12 months. The forecasted prices are reviewed every three months and adjusted accordingly. If our forecasts are over or under our actual costs, the difference is refunded or collected from customers through cost adjustments.

Customer Charge

The customer charge increased to \$148.76 a month to partially recover some of the fixed costs associated with maintaining a safe and reliable natural gas distribution system.

Delivery to You

The delivery rates that vary with consumption increased based on our forecast cost of delivering natural gas to your business. These charges include a facility carbon charge associated with the operation of Enbridge Gas' facilities to deliver natural gas to you. The facility carbon charge has increased from 0.0123 cents per cubic metre (¢/m³) to 0.0145 ¢/m³.

Load Balancing Charge

The load balancing charge has increased due to higher seasonal load balancing related costs and changes to Enbridge Gas' 2026 rates.

Transportation to Enbridge

The 'Transportation to Enbridge' charge has increased due to higher costs for transporting natural gas to Ontario and Enbridge Gas' 2026 rates.

Gas Supply Commodity Charge

The gas supply commodity charge has increased from 12.3004 ¢/m³ to 13.7858 ¢/m³ based on our forecast of natural gas market prices for the next 12 months and Enbridge Gas' 2026 rates.

Enbridge Gas does not make a profit on the price of natural gas.

Cost Adjustment

The current adjustment is a refund of 2.5821 ¢/m³. Please see the included chart for the breakdown by component.

Rate Adjustment

This rate adjustment to reflect the clearance of 2023 Utility Earnings and Disposition of Deferral and Variance Accounts (UEDVA) balances from Jan. 1, 2023 to Dec. 31, 2023 will appear as a one-time adjustment on customers' January bills. This adjustment will be a refund of 0.5618 ¢/m³.
