## Natural Gas Prices Have Changed

The Ontario Energy Board (OEB) has approved changes to the rates Enbridge Gas charges its customers effective **April 1, 2025**.

On average, these changes will amount to an increase of approximately 20.2 percent annually. The total impact on your bill will depend on how much gas your organization uses.

Your current bill has been calculated using the new approved rates for gas consumed from April 1, 2025. The rate chart is included in this notice.

Our supply prices are based on a forecast of market prices for the next 12 months. The forecasted prices are reviewed every three months and adjusted accordingly. If our forecasts are over or under our actual costs, the difference is refunded or collected from customers through cost adjustments.

## Delivery to You

The delivery rates that vary with consumption increased based on our forecast cost of delivering natural gas to your business. These charges also include a facility carbon charge associated with the operation of Enbridge Gas' facilities to deliver natural gas to you. The facility carbon charge has increased from 0.0143 cents per metre ( $\text{¢}/\text{m}^3$ ) to 0.0172  $\text{¢}/\text{m}^3$ .

The delivery rates on your bill include a charge for the 2024 rate adjustment (Rider E) as approved by the OEB. Details for these rate adjustments can be found in the rate adjustment section below.

## Load Balancing Charge

The load balancing charge has increased due to higher seasonal load balancing related costs.

## Transportation to Enbridge

The 'Transportation to Enbridge' charge has increased due to higher costs for transporting natural gas to Ontario. The transportation charge includes a charge for the 2024 rate adjustment (Rider E) as approved by the OEB. Details for this rate adjustment can be found in the rate adjustment section below.

## Federal Carbon Charge

The federal carbon charge will be removed from customer bills effective April 1, 2025. Please note that your bill will continue to show federal carbon charges incurred for any natural gas usage up to and including March 31, 2025. Some businesses may be eligible for full or partial exemption from this charge under the federal carbon pricing program.

## Gas Supply Commodity Charge

The gas supply commodity charge has increased from 9.1858  $\text{¢}/\text{m}^3$  to 10.7714  $\text{¢}/\text{m}^3$  based on our forecast of natural gas market prices for the next 12 months.

The gas supply commodity charge includes a charge for the 2024 rate adjustment (Rider E) as approved by the OEB. Details for this rate adjustment can be found in the rate adjustment section below.

Enbridge Gas does not make a profit on the price of natural gas.

## Cost Adjustment

The current adjustment is a refund of 0.8100  $\text{¢}/\text{m}^3$ . Please see the included chart for the breakdown by component.

## Rate Adjustment

The OEB-approved Rider E rate adjustment to reflect the changes to Enbridge Gas' 2024 rates for the period of Jan. 1, 2024 to Dec. 31, 2024 will continue be applied to customers bills from Jan. 1, 2025 to Dec. 31, 2025. The following adjustments will be included in each component of your bill, if applicable:

Delivery Charge - Contract Demand	0.0306 ¢/m <sup>3</sup>
Delivery Charge - Commodity	0.0009 ¢/m <sup>3</sup>
Gas Supply Transportation Charge	0.0002 ¢/m <sup>3</sup>
Gas Supply Transportation Dawn Charge	0.0019 ¢/m <sup>3</sup>
Gas Supply Commodity Charge*	0.0002 ¢/m <sup>3</sup>

The total impact on your bill will depend on how much your organization uses.

The OEB has approved a rate adjustment to reflect the clearance of 2023 federal carbon deferral and variance account balances. This will appear as a one-time refund on customers' April bills:

Non-EPS: A total refund of 0.0011 ¢/m<sup>3</sup>

EPS: A total refund of 0.0011 ¢/m<sup>3</sup>

\* The total effective gas supply rate shown on your bill is 9.5707 ¢/m<sup>3</sup>. The rate is the sum of the gas supply charge of 10.7714 ¢/m<sup>3</sup>, the gas cost adjustment of (1.2009) ¢/m<sup>3</sup>, and the rate adjustment gas supply commodity charge of 0.0002 ¢/m<sup>3</sup>. The total effective gas supply charge has increased since the last rate change.

\*\* The Gas Supply Commodity Charge is applicable if the customer purchases their natural gas requirement from Enbridge Gas (System Sales).
