

IMPORTANT NOTICE

Safety check of natural gas service pipe and meters



Sorry we missed you. We were here today to inspect the natural gas service pipe and meter at your property. This inspection is required to ensure that the underground natural gas service pipe and meter are still operating safely.

There is no cost for this inspection. To complete our work, we require access to your property. The inspection will be carried out by an authorized Enbridge Gas employee or contractor.

Please call the authorized contractor provided on the card you received to arrange an appointment as soon as possible.

- Appointment times are available Monday to Friday from 7 – 11 a.m. and 11 a.m. – 2 p.m.
- If you cannot be home, it is still important to call so arrangements can be made to access the natural gas meter in your absence.
- To prepare for the inspection, we ask that you provide a clear path, move anything blocking the area, and ensure pets are secured.
