Natural gas rates have changed

Rate M1 Union South



New natural gas rates

The Ontario Energy Board (OEB) has approved changes to the rates Enbridge Gas charges its customers effective **July 1, 2025**.

For a typical customer the total annual bill decrease will be \$43.22. The total impact on your bill will depend on how much gas you use.

Delivery to You

The delivery charges that vary with consumption decreased based on our forecast cost of delivering natural gas to your home or business. These charges include a facility carbon charge associated with the operation of Enbridge Gas' facilities to deliver natural gas to you. The facility carbon charge has decreased from 0.0172 cents per cubic metre (¢/m³) to 0.0123 ¢/m³. The delivery charges on your bill also include a charge for the 2024 rate adjustment as approved by the OEB. Details for this rate adjustment can be found in the rate adjustment section below.

Federal Carbon Charge

The federal carbon charge was removed from customer bills effective April 1, 2025. Please note that your bill will show federal carbon charges incurred for any gas usage up to and including March 31, 2025.

Gas Supply Commodity Charge

The gas supply commodity charge has decreased from 19.8683 ¢/m³ to 18.8148 ¢/m³ based on our forecast of natural gas market prices for the next 12 months. The gas supply commodity charge includes a charge for the 2024 rate adjustment as approved by the OEB. Details for this rate adjustment can be found in the rate adjustment section below.

Cost Adjustment

The current adjustment is a refund of 0.2030 ¢/m³. The cost adjustment reflects the true-up between actual and forecast prices for prior periods. Please see the included chart for the breakdown by component.

Rate Adjustments

The OEB has approved a rate adjustment to reflect the difference between the amount customers paid for the energy conservation programs (DSM) from Jan. 1 to Dec. 31, 2022 and the actual costs incurred. On July bills, this will appear as a one-time charge of approximately \$0.51 for a typical customer.

The OEB has approved an interim rate adjustment to collect a portion of the difference between the amount customers paid for the energy conservation programs (DSM) from Jan. 1 to Dec. 31, 2024 and the actual costs incurred. On July bills, this will appear as a one-time charge of approximately \$16.71 for a typical customer.

The OEB-approved rate adjustment to reflect changes to Enbridge Gas' 2024 rates to recover the revenue variance between the approved effective date of Jan. 1, 2024 and the implementation date of Jan. 1, 2025, will continue to be applied from Jan. 1, 2025 to Dec. 31, 2025 and will be included in the Delivery to You, Transportation to Enbridge and Gas Supply Commodity sections. The total impact on your bill will depend on your usage.

Charges for gas used from July 1, 2025 will be calculated using the new approved rates as shown in the chart. The annualized impact is based on a typical Rate M1 - Union South customer who uses 2,200 cubic metres (m³) per year.

The total effective gas supply charge has decreased since the last rate change.
